A note will be sent home with these swimmers as soon as we have the Diocese carnival information.


I would like to thank all parents who travelled to Coonamble and their support on the day. Thanks to those parents who volunteered their time to help time keep on the day and for their support.

ASH WEDNESDAY



Ash Wednesday is one of the most popular and important holy days in the liturgical calendar. **Ash Wednesday** opens Lent, a season of fasting and prayer. **It** takes place 46 days before Easter Sunday, when we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus. On **Ash** Wednesday, we will have **ashes** applied to **our foreheads** in **the** shape of a cross. People generally wear **the ashes** — which symbolize penance, mourning and mortality — throughout **the** day to publicly express **their** faith and penance.
